



## CHILEAN PRESIDENT GABRIEL BORIC RECEIVES A DELEGATION OF CHILEAN DOCKERS AND THE IDC

On July 21, representatives of the Chilean Port Union and the International Dockworkers' Council (IDC), including the Coordinator of the Latin American Zone, the Chilean César Luna, and the International Labor Coordinator, Jordi Aragunde, among others, met at the Palacio de la Moneda, seat of government, with the President of the Republic of Chile, Gabriel Boric, the Minister of Transport, Juan Carlos Muñoz, and several advisors.

During the meeting, the present and future of the port sector in Chile was presented and discussed, through a document delivered and subsequently signed

by President Boric, in which the main problems were presented.

Thursday's meeting resulted in a commitment by the Government on four key points for the sector:

- The development of a tripartite table, where Government, companies and workers have the same voice for the development of a new General Ports Law.
- To elaborate a Law that regulates port activity and promotes its development.
- Enact a law regulating national cabotage before the end of this year.
- To activate City-Port commissions creating an economic-social link between port activity and

From the meeting it was agreed that all these proposals will be taken as a matter of urgency.

#### THE IDC, PRESENT AT THE CONGRESS OF THE FEDERAÇÃO NACIONAL DOS ESTIVADORES (FNE)

The Federação Nacional dos Estivadores (FNE) of Brazil, a member of the International Dockworkers' Council (IDC) held its XIV National Congress from August 31 to September 2. The IDC was represented at the Congress by the Latin America and Caribbean Zone Coordinator, César Luna, and the International Labor Coordinator, Jordi Aragunde.

During the Congress, which gathered in São Luís (Maranhão) dozens of representatives of Brazilian port workers, a deep reflection was made on the current situation of national ports in the international context and institutional support was offered to the candidate Luiz Inacio Lula da Silva in the general elections for the presidency to be held on October 2.
