OSHA's Field Staff Changing Hats

Today, the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) has issued a press release announcing that it will be outfitting its field staff with Safety Helmets (as contrasted with the more traditional "Hard Hats" we've become used to seeing on the waterfront).
