



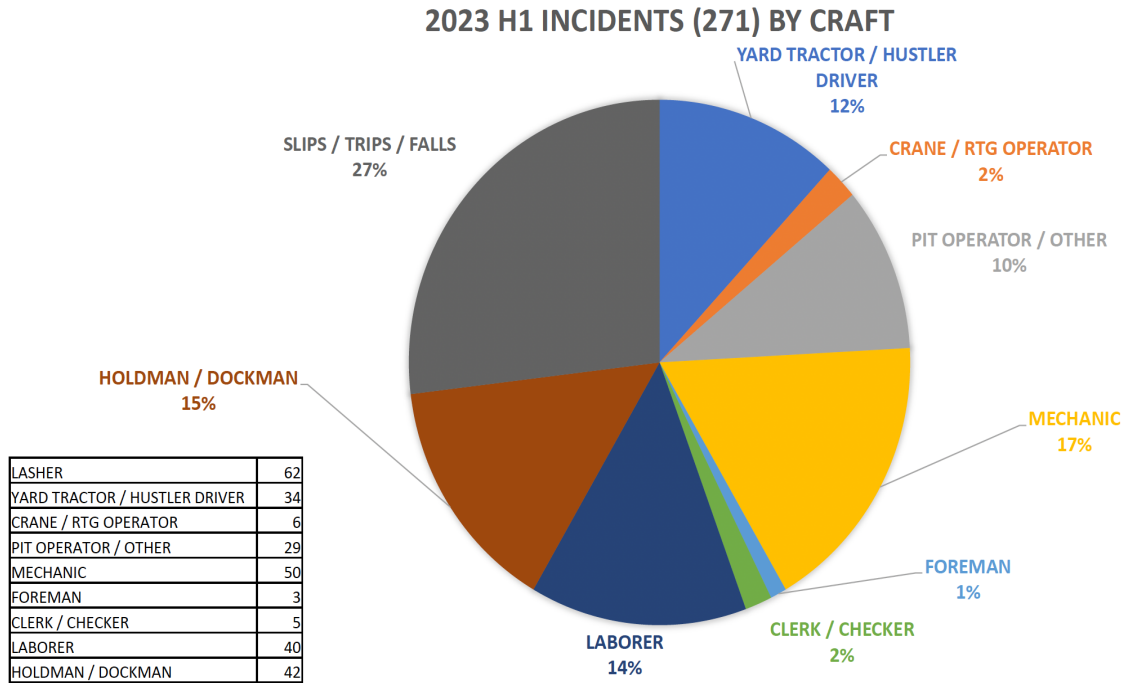

Who's Getting Hurt ?

The refined lost time injury data for 1st Half (January-June) 2023 for combined ILA-USMX ports has become available and is presented in pie graph format below.

From such data, we see that of the 271 lost time accidents experienced the top five (5) categories of workers included were: **Lashers**, who accrued 62 of those 271 accidents (29 percent); **Mechanics**, who accrued 50 of those 271 accidents (17 percent); **Holdmen/Dockmen**, who accrued 42 of those 271 accidents (15 percent); **Laborers**, who accrued 40 of those 271 accidents (14 percent); and **Yard Tractor Operators**, who accrued 34 of those 271 accidents (12 percent).
